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Eugene Civic Alliance Announces Selection of Architects to Build Civic Park

Eugene Civic Alliance has selected the team of Robertson/Sherwood/Architects pc and Skylab Architecture to design the new Civic Park project.

“We are excited to get the design process started,” said Carole Knapel, ECA project manager. The Design and Construction Committee selected Robertson/Sherwood and Skylab from four strong proposals submitted earlier this year in response to ECA’s formal request for qualifications. “Both of these firms have a lot of experience designing recreation facilities,” said Knapel, “and they stood out because they have taken to heart our vision: to create a lively hub for our community and a place for everyone to get out and play.”

The architects will begin work immediately on Phase I, which will help ECA re-imagine how to make the best use of the Civic space for the Kidsports Fieldhouse, the turf field and 2,500-seat stadium. This scope and programming process will take 3-4 months and will cost approximately \$225,000. The process will also help ECA define a revised budget for Phase II—the detailed design and construction of the facilities and fields.

Robertson/Sherwood/Architects of Eugene will be the architect of record. Skylab Architecture of Portland will be Design Architect on the project.

ECA, founded in 2014, is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation established to redevelop the historic Civic Stadium property into an inclusive, long-term, self-sustaining community sports and entertainment venue, operated primarily to benefit the children of the community. ECA owns the site free and clear.

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
